Demonstration of Learning will take on a different format this year due to COVID 19. It will take place on November 19 and have two parts to it. Firstly, each teacher and student has set up, in their Google Classroom, a Demonstration of Learning slide show for you to view. This way you can see what your child has accomplished during the first two months of school. Secondly, you can set up a 10-minute virtual Teams meeting or a 10-minute phone meeting with your child's teacher by following the link below and entering the code. You will then select the teacher you wish to meet with, the type meeting you wish to have and the time you will meet. It is important to view the Google Slides before your meeting so that you can discuss it with the teacher. POWERSCHOOL PARENT/STUDENT PORTAL

The Edmonton Catholic Schools PowerSchool parent and student portal is a secure website that allows parents and students to access attendance, grades, fees and student information in real time.

IN IT'S SECOND YEAR, IS STUDENT ONGOING REPORTING!

PowerSchool is used for all students/parents from Kindergarten to grade 12. It is critical that you have access to your account. Ensure that you remember your username and password. Once your account is set up you have it for as long as your child is registered with ECSD. You can then log into your account to look at your child's progress at any time throughout the school year and see the summary reports at the end of January and June.
