We are giving families until **Monday, August 16** to make a <u>final decision</u> between online and in-person learning. Please ensure that the name of St. Vladimir School and your child's full name are included in the subject line. **If your intentions have not changed, no response is necessary.** 

For the 2021-2022 school year, online elementary and junior high students will attend <u>Genesis Catholic Online Elementary/Junior High School</u>. As a reminder, students choosing online learning would be committed to that choice and will only have one opportunity to return to in-person learning at their community school – at the start of the second semester in February. Parents will be given ample time to let us know their plans.

## **Important Dates:**

Monday, August 16 – Deadline for learning choice

**Wednesday, September 1** – First day of school for online and in-person

**January 2022** – Students who were registered for online learning will have the opportunity to return to their community school for the start of semester two. This will be the only opportunity to switch to inperson.

**Tuesday, February 1** – First day of semester two.
