#### **CROSSWALK SAFETY**

As the school year draws to a close, we would like to remind St. Vladimir families the importance of maintaining crosswalk safety:

- Be aware of your surroundings and stay alert when crossing the street
- Maintain eye contact with drivers and wait until vehicles have stopped before you cross
- Only cross the street at designated crossing points
- Get noticed! Wear light-coloured or reflective clothing when walking in low light or poor weather conditions
- Don't start crossing after the walk light has ended
- Unplug, don't be a distracted walker
- Watch for vehicles turning as you cross intersections
- If a vehicle has stopped for you in a crosswalk, don't assume that it's safe to cross the remaining lanes of traffic
- Make sure all vehicles have seen you and will stop for you before proceeding





Make eye contact.

Don't walk until traffic stops.



Be bright at night. Wear reflectors.
